## SPARKLING αφρώδες κρασί

- 14 Domaine Spiropoulos 'Ode Panos' Brut, Mantinia, Peloponnese 58  
Stone fruits and flowers. Nectar of the gods.
- 13 Tselepos 'Amalia' Brut, Nemea, Peloponnese 90  
Better than Veuve. (For real, though.)
- NV Tselepos 'Amalia' Brut Roze, Nemea, Peloponnese 60  
Roze all day! Berries and herbs. Fresh, vibrant, pink.

## WHITE λευκό κρασί

- 16 Roditis / Moschofilero, Gai'a 'Notios,' Peloponnese 34  
Easygoing and easy to love. Tropical, fresh, and second-bottle-worthy.
- 17 Moschofilero, Tselepos, Mantinia, Peloponnese 40  
New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc lovers, meet Moschofilero (aka your new bestie)
- 16 Vidiano / Plyto, Rhous 'Skipper,' Crete 57  
Lush and citrus-driven. Fine minerality keeps it so fresh and so clean.
- 14 Assyrtiko, Athini, Klíma Parparoussis 'Barrel Fermented,' Achaia, Peloponnese 57  
Assyrtiko from another mother. Less salt, more fruit, max joy. (I heads-up, dry Chard peeps.)
- 17 Muscat of Alexandria, Garalis 'Terra Ambera,' Lemnos 60  
Like standing in a citrus grove on a summer afternoon. Also, you're in love.
- 15 Robola, Sklavos 'Vino di Sasso,' Kefalonia 54  
Drink this. Trust.
- 16 Assyrtiko / Malagouzia / Asprouda, Domaine Nerantzi 'Pentapolis,' Serres, Macedonia 42  
A full-fruited mic-drop from a father-daughter team in the hills of Northern Greece.
- 16 Assyrtiko, Gai'a 'Wild Ferment,' Santorini 66  
Want a little oak on your Assyrtiko? Ain't no shame in that. Ripe and opulent.
- 15 Assyrtiko, Hatzidakis 'Vignes Centenaires,' Louros, Pyrgos, Santorini 175  
The be-all, end-all. Here 'til it's gone forever. (Grand Cru Burgundy, you're on notice.)
- 17 Assyrtiko, Venetsanos 'Nyktleri,' Santorini 96  
Stay up all night with this super old-school power-hitter. Assyrtiko, turned up to 11.

## ORANGE πορτοκαλί κρασί

- 17 Sideritis, Klíma Parparoussis 'Petite Fleur,' Achaia, Peloponnese 56  
A distinctive take on pink from the OG master of Peloponnesian terrior.
- 17 Roditis / Moschata / Vostylidi / Muscat, Sklavos 'Alchymiste,' Kefalonia 38  
Dip your toes in the orange wine pool with this staff fave. Aromatic and affable.
- 17 Savatiano, Georgas Family, Spata 48  
Rustic and earthy, from the hottest, driest region in Greece. Sort of miracle wine.
- NV Aspro Potamisi / Roseaki, Kthalas 'Un Été Grec,' Tinos 120  
The new cult classic. Drink it now so you can say you knew it when...

## RED ερυθρό κρασί

- 14 Agiorgitiko, Leropoulos, Nemea, Peloponnese 198  
Special sauce. Move over, Burgundy, it's Agiorgitiko's time to shine.
- 16 Mandilaria, Venetsanos, Santorini 96  
Hello, do you like your finesse with a splash of power? Drink this. Berries and earth.
- 12 Agiorgitiko, Klíma Parparoussis 'Reserve,' Nemea, Peloponnese 99  
Oregon Pinot lovers, proceed with caution: You're about to rethink your relationship.
- 17 Mavrodafni, Sant'Or 'Krasis,' Achaia, Peloponnese 49  
Tiny estate, big complexity. Elegance, structure, bramble, boom.
- 15 Mavrodafni Blend, Klíma Parparoussis 'Oenofilos,' Achaia, Peloponnese 56  
Like Bordeaux, but better. (Way better.)
- 13 Xinomavro, Kir-Yianni 'Ramnista,' Naoussa 52  
Old-school gets a New World reboot with ripe red fruit and warm spice.
- 15 Agiorgitiko, Papantonis 'Meden Again,' Nemea, Peloponnese 45  
'Meden Agan' means "nothing in excess." Perfect for novices or seasoned lovers alike.
- 04 Liatiko, Economou, Sitia, Crete 140  
The moment we've all been waiting for. Like Barolo, mid-Mediterranean love affair.
- 13 Limnio Blend, Klíma Gerovassiliou 'Avaton', Macedonia 120  
Roll like an Athens playboy. Malbec-y.
- 15 Kotsifali / Mandilaria, Rhous 'Skipper,' Crete 60  
It's earthy, it's smoky, it's cherry, it's Kotsifali.
- 16 Limnio, Garalis, Lemnos 50  
The oldest recorded grape in human history. Aristotle drank it. (So should you.)
- 10 Koniaros, Domaine Nerantzi, Serres, Macedonia 156  
From the last known vineyard of Koniaros on Earth. Have a little taste of history tonight.
- 07 Cabernet Sauvignon, Katsaros, Mount Olympus 110  
It's Cabernet grown on the slopes of Mount Olympus. Come on.
- 14 Xinomavro, Domaine Karydas, Naoussa 54  
Do you like a challenge? Suit up for some true tar and roses.
